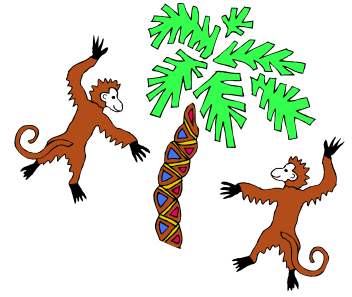




# Welcome to 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade!
